UNIVERSITY AND LOUIS BEVIER GRADUATE AND DISSERTATION FELLOWSHIPS

The Graduate School-New Brunswick expects to award thirteen University and Louis Bevier Graduate Fellowships for the 2009-2010 academic year. One fellowship (with a stipend of \$20,000) will be reserved for a graduate of any undergraduate division of the University who will begin his or her program of doctoral study in the Graduate School-New Brunswick during the Fall 2009 term. Twelve Dissertation Fellowships will be reserved for students who will have completed their qualifying examinations and have begun their thesis research by the beginning of the Fall 2009 term. Applicants must have an approved dissertation proposal. Doctoral students in all programs in the Graduate School-New Brunswick (School 16) are eligible. The fellowships carry a stipend of \$18,000. Fellows may not hold other full-time awards concurrently with University or Louis Bevier Fellowships.
