

Approval of Examination/Dissertation Defense Committee Membership—Neuroscience

The role of the Examination/Dissertation Defense Committee is to guide the candidate during the period of thesis research. Responsibilities include the following:

1. Ensure that "Part I" of the Neuroscience Qualifying Exam is completed by the end of the 2nd year of graduate study;
2. Participate in annual research committee meetings of the student beginning in the second year of graduate study as required by the Neuroscience Program;
3. Ensure that the thesis proposal "Part II" of the qualifying exam is completed by the end of the third year of graduate study;
4. Approve the Final Examination/Dissertation Defense.

The Committee composition is determined by the program and the degree type.

This Committee serves as the Final Examination Committee at the Dissertation Defense and must approve the thesis in order for the degree to be awarded.
